Our core mission is to support the children within their own families and children are only removed and brought to our children's home for residential care in emergency situations. Once they are settled with us, SALEM maintains contact with their original families and helps them to access education and vocational training they need to build a sustainable future for themselves.

SALEM relies on sponsorship to continue our vital work. There are two ways you can do this: by donating to the project as a whole, or by personally sponsoring a child.

Project sponsorship means that we are able to use your donation wherever there is greatest need and this is crucial to enable us to adapt to the changing needs of our children, enabling their long-term, appropriate professional care and support. When you opt for project sponsorship, donations do not just benefit one individual child but are used for the development of the home as a whole. If you opt to receive emails, you will be kept up to date with work at SALEM-Uganda as a whole.

Now Johnny lives an active life in the SALEM children's home where he has his own bed, nutritious food to eat and is doing well in school. He loves to run and play with the other children and is growing up to be strong and healthy with the chance of a stable future ahead of him.

Her mother died in childbirth. She has four siblings and was left by her maternal grandfather who was unable to cope raising all five children alone.
